#### **1. Aراها Beach (Chatan Town)**

Kick off your journey with ocean views and American Village nearby!

##### **Highlights:**

- Beach vibes, sunset strolls, and cafes
- Overnight parking available (in/out access restricted from 10 PM to 6 AM)
- Public restrooms, 100-yen showers (until 8 PM), and *Terme Villa Onsen* (open until 11 PM / ¥1,600)

 *Tip:* Great place to relax before heading north!

#### **2. Onna Village & Tiger Beach**

Famous for stunning coastline and resort charm.

##### **Highlights:**

- Park near Tomiarai Community Center
- Visit *Tiger Beach*—a little-known national park beach beside Halekulani Hotel
- Say you're visiting the café to access hotel parking

 Restrooms and foot-wash stations available along the beach

#### **3. Motobu Campsite Area**

Enjoy camping near Okinawa's top attractions.

**Recommended:** Yagaji Beach or Karst Campsite

**Nearby:** Bise Fukugi Tree Road & Churaumi Aquarium


 *Great for families and nature lovers!*

#### **4. Remote Island Camping (via Unten Port Ferry)**

Get off the beaten path with a ferry ride to:

- **Ie Island:** *Ie Village Youth Travel Village*

- **Izena Island:** *Izena Beach Campground*

 *Facilities available; walk-in campers welcome!*
